## **PSHE**

This term our PSHE topic is 'Dreams and Goals'. Children will identify their own learning strengths and goals, considering the learning steps needed to reach these. They will identify problems in the world that concern them and work with others to help make the world a better place. We will think about what we admire about ourselves and others in our class.

#### Art

We will continue to explore the artistic technique of printing this term. Children will identify different printmaking techniques used by Inuit artists and experiment further with different techniques, evaluating as they go.

## RE

Our RE this term will focus on the question: Why is there suffering? We will draw connections between stories from scripture; understand different perspectives on suffering; and recognise how people respond to suffering.

### Music

In our music lessons, we will learn new musical skills/concepts and revisit them over time with increasing depth and confidence.

# Scorpions Curriculum Term 4



## **Maths**

Our Maths lessons will start with some work on decimals (adding and subtracting then multiplying and dividing by integers). We will know how to find the area and perimeter of different shapes. Year 6 will explore volume before we all move on to statistics. In this unit, we will complete, read and interpret information in tables and graphs.

### **English**

We will begin by finishing our non-chronological reports about Polar animals before moving on to recount writing based on 'Island' by Jason Chin. In our guided reading lessons, we will explore a non-fiction text about the Amazon to give us background knowledge for reading 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell. We will develop our skills of vocabulary understanding, inference, prediction, retrieval, summarising and make connections between stories.

## Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be learning to touch-type. We will learn typing letters in rows, typing keys on the home row and start thinking about typing with punctuation.

## Geography

We continue our topic 'Frozen Kingdoms' this term. We will explore different natural resources; find out about the Indigenous people of the Arctic; recognise the impact of tourism in the Antarctic; and research into the life of Shackleton and the Titanic.

#### Science

'Animals including Humans' is our topic this term. We will explore different gestation periods and recognise the development of human babies and children. We will identify and describe the changes as humans develop to old age.

## PE

In PE this term, we will continue developing our basketball skills when playing as part of a team. We will also be developing our knowledge and skills whilst playing tennis.

#### French

We will continue to develop our vocabulary in French and make grammatical connections between French and English.
