Gas Network Upgrade

A reminder that further roadwork in Faversham will begin shortly.

The SGN have detailed the essential gas network upgrades will be on the following roads:

Whitstable Road – from 13 January we'll be replacing our pipes along the road using two-way traffic lights for approximately 300m. We'll be working from the junction with Head Hill to the junction with Homestall Lane.

Graveney Road - From 20 January, due to the width of the road and the position of our pipes, we'll need to install a road closure around our work site as we move past Homestall Lane and on to Graveney Road. The closure point will move with us up to the junction with Love Lane.

Love Lane - From 10 February, we'll be using two-way traffic lights on the Love Lane Roundabout, with Graveney Road remaining closed while we replace the final section of our pipework across the railway bridge.

Signed diversions will be in place for affected motorists where roads are closed. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses.

We know that this will be very inconvenient for many of you. Please plan your routes carefully as they do seem to be moving them along the road as they are replacing the pipes.
